Footnotes

CROCKEFELLER prompted the pace outside CELESTIAL FIELDS, moved to command leaving the three sixteenths marker, dueled under left handed urging and held firm. CELESTIAL FIELDS set a pressured pace along the inside, drifted off the rail nearing the lane, battled back to near even terms leaving the sixteenth marker, finished gamely but just wasn't good enough. SIR FIT'S TOO MUCH, taken to rate early while four wide stalking the pace, came five wide for the drive and finished up willingly to regain the show. JONS MASTER DANCER stumbled at the break spotting the field a few lengths, recovered and made steady progress inside rivals nearing the half mile marker, tracked the leaders around the turn, worked outward inside the eighth pole then flattened out late. ROMAN CANDLE LIGHT lacked speed while between rivals, was ridden along mid turn but lacked a solid run. SKY WARS, between horses early, saved ground into the lane and lacked a rally. AUSTRITY MEASURES, four wide most of the trip, was not a factor.
