Footnotes

WOHALI disputed the pace outside PRIVATE NOTICE and drove clear late. TEN MISSIONS hugged the rail on the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, rallied between horses and bumped with G MAN JOE near the sixteenth pole. ROYAL LOUIE chased the pace, entered the stretch three wide, drifted out in midstretch and flattened out. G MAN JOE , three wide entering the stretch, raced between horses, bumped with TEN MISSIONS and BLADING SILVER near the sixteenth pole and closed the gap late. BLADING SILVER , wide entering the stretch, failed to sustain his bid and bumped with G MAN JOE near the sixteenth pole. PRIVATE NOTICE saved ground, disputed the pace to the sixteenth pole then gave way. CONNECTION BOX was outrun. CONCERTO'S RELIC bobbled leaving the starting gate, was outrun and turned for home in the six path. DISTINCTIVE ALIBI , wide, stalked the pace, stopped after a half mile and was eased through the stretch.
