DUEL IN THE SUN broke a step slow, was hustled up between rivals soon after, prompted the pace along the rail while under rating, moved to command after a half mile, kicked clear in upper stretch and maintained a safe margin while kept to pressure. GULLY , four to five wide early, advanced between rivals leaving the three eighths pole, angled in for the drive and closed nicely. EDDIE LOVES MONEY had speed off the rail, took pressure around the turn, drifted four wide entering the stretch, was straightened away and gave way grudgingly. TEA TOTT was steadied back from between foes near the four and a half furlong pole, came three wide into the stretch, shifted out wider and some belated action. TOM THE BUILDER vied early inside rivals, was rated back off the pace and angled three wide nearing the turn, stalked the leaders three wide mid turn, was floated out five wide by EDDIE LOVES MONEY entering the stretch then faded. NICKEL PLATE LINE bobbled at the break, chased the pace towards the inside and weakened. CALL ME FRANKIE hopped at the break, recovered and raced forwardly early while off the rail, chased the pace around the turn and tired after a half mile. PASS ON THE RIGHT , sluggish from the gate, was outrun and raced towards the inside in the drive.
