Footnotes

CUTTER chased the pace, bid for the lead outside LONDON TOWN near the three eighths pole, dueled with that one and narrowly prevailed under brisk urging. LONDON TOWN set the pace along the rail, dueled the final three furlongs and just missed in a game effort. DESTINEDTOBEMINE, steadied and rank when in tight quarters approaching the first turn, circled rivals to reach a striking position leaving the backstretch and gave way approaching the stretch. SANTA FE CHIEF lacked speed, raced three wide entering the stretch and passed tired rivals. CHAMP TONY saved ground and gave way. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND, four wide the first turn, was four wide turning for home and dropped back. FINGER TAPPING, three wide the first turn, stopped.
