Footnotes

THE LAST DANCER lodged a two wide bid into the turn, dueled and gained a short lead three furlongs out, went clear mid turn, was joined in mid stretch, drifted out through the final sixteenth and dug in gamely under stout left handed pressure to prevail. ICE ON THE SIDE, taken to rate in a stalking position, advanced three wide nearing the lane, ranged up four wide in mid stretch, battled outside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. CONGRESIONALAFFAIR lacked speed while saving ground, was put to a ride around the turn, angled out wide for the drive and closed belatedly. PURELY FANCY stumbled to the front, was joined along the rail entering the turn, dueled past the three eighths pole, held well to the three sixteenths marker then weakened. OUR LAINEY was outrun. DREAMING PRAYERS chased the early pace four wide and dropped back. HUNKA'S VICTORY bolted near the three eighths pole.
