MOUNT WILTON came in at the break and was bumped, disputed the pace two to three wide, held a short lead between rivals in mid stretch and just missed in a sharp effort. HANDSOME BRUNO broke outward causing some bumping, dueled early along the rail, held a clear lead into the turn, took pressure into the lane, continued to battle past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. PRINCE OF TRICKS broke outward and crowded ANTHONY J., saved ground stalking the pace, moved closer mid turn, angled out entering the stretch then lacked a solid finish. ANTHONY J. was roughed up at the break, raced well back for six furlongs then had some belated wide action. LOCKET INCLUDED failed to menace. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the rider of ANTHONY J., PRINCE OF TRICKS was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for causing interference leaving the starting gate
