**Footnotes**

ECONOMIC RISK prompted the pace three to four wide, responded in upper stretch, forged clear departing the furlong grounds and held sway under a drive. MAGIC FIRE saved ground, edged closer nearing the quarter pole, steadied lacking room in upper stretch, shifted out inside the sixteenth pole and closed between rivals to get the place. TANKA , three wide in range, was ridden along mid turn, shifted out wider for the drive, closed the gap but was outfinished for the place. STORMING RAGE , hard sent along the rail to go clear leaving the five eighths pole, took pressure past mid turn, held well to the sixteenth marker then faded. ABIGAIL ADAMS , bumped with ARANN at the break, was hustled along four wide chasing the pace and came up empty. LIBERTYTOWN LASS prompted the pace two wide, challenged between rivals past the five sixteenths marker, vied to to upper stretch then weakened. ARANN , bumped at the break, lagged back, swung out wide late and failed to menace.
