Footnotes

DEB'S HONOR, unhurried early, advanced two wide the final turn, awaited room behind a wall of horses in upper stretch, rallied between rivals, angled out late and surged gamely under left handed pressure. INDIAN HEAD PENNY set the pace under rating towards the inside, drew well clear in upper stretch, drifted out and just failed. SMASHING REVIEW, three wide both turns, stalked the pace, came five wide for the drive and finished willingly. GLAMOUR GIRL, between horses early, angled to the rail the final turn, moved closer in the drive then faded. FINAL ONE saved ground, was put to a drive near the three furlong marker and lacked a closing response. SAINT AUBIN broke outward and was outrun. STOP THAT BROAD never menaced. GLADYS J, three to four wide throughout, prompted the pace until the stretch then weakened. SHUTTERED prompted the pace in the two path, was urged along on the final turn then gave way in upper stretch.
