TRIPPI'S WISH rated kindly two to three wide stalking the clear leader, came under a ride leaving the far turn, steadily progressed and took over in upper stretch, responded to left handed pressure and drew away. CITRON LADY settled back in the two path, was sent up between rivals near the half mile pole, angled to the rail for the run around the final turn, eased out for the drive and just gained the place over a tiring foe. MISS BAD GIRL cleared early, set the pace along the rail, met the winner approaching the lane, held well to the eighth pole then gradually gave way. MAGNIFICENT IMAGE , three wide, raced on her left lead chasing in the stretch and came up empty. COUGAR HILL , five wide the first turn, lost ground five wide from the three quarter pole to the quarter pole, shifted in some but failed to threaten. WILL UNBRIDLED saved ground, dropped back around the far turn, swung out late but failed to make an impact. GALLANT KITTYKAT , four wide the first turn, raced three wide chasing down the backstretch and faltered.
