Footnotes

ST JOHN'S GOSPEL moved up inside to gain a stalking spot in the opening furlong, edged closer when nudged along leaving the far turn, eased out for a clear run departing the five sixteenths marker, closed under strong handling to take over in mid stretch then eagerly kicked clear. SILENT SCORE settled early, was taken wide leaving the far turn, ranged up four wide into the lane, gave willing pursuit but was second best. ROMAN'S TOUCH cleared early, set the pace towards the rail, was collared in upper stretch, gave way grudgingly and ended up in a dead heat for the show. SANDBAGIN' LOVER, taken to rate early, saved ground into the lane and had a mild response to be on even terms with ROMAN'S TOUCH. SAY MR. SANDMAN bobbled inward at the break, settled well off the early pace while saving ground, swung four wide into the stretch and had a belated response. CLASSIC SPEED, away alertly, stalked the pace three wide and tired entering the stretch. NINETY FIVE SOUTH broke through the gate pre race, chased the early pace while between runners then surrendered before going a half mile.
