FLIPOFTHecoin stalked the early pace, circled the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch then drew away under energetic urging. QUIET INTENT , two wide on the turn, angled to the four path near the three sixteenths pole then rallied outside horses. WARMWOOLENMITTENS , two wide leaving the turn, chased the pace, lacked room near the eighth pole then split rivals near the sixteenth pole with a game rally. JOSIE HOMEMAKER set a pressured pace along the rail and weakened the final furlong. SUBIRA prompted the pace outside JOSEI HOMEMAKER and gave way in midstretch. WAKINA drifted wide leaving the turn and gave way. DESSERT FIRST , wide on the turn, was outrun. SHARP DAY flashed brief speed along the rail.
