FORDANGSHORE vied two wide under a snug hold the opening quarter mile, moved to command into the far turn, took pressure from BANDBOX from the three eighths pole, responded to steady encouragement and held that rival at bay. BANDBOX , in close attendance three wide, moved to challenge after a half mile, was put to strong urging approaching the lane, continued on gamely but just could not forge ahead. MALIBU KID , forwardly place off the inside, shifted out four wide under urging for the drive but lacked a response. INDIAN DANCE , pinched back at the break, lagged far back through five furlongs, swung out six wide in upper stretch and had some late action. BROAD RULE , well placed under rating into the turn, angled five wide into the lane and faded. THOMAS GOT EVEN , in close at the break, dropped well off the early pace, saved ground into the lane, angled out but failed to generate a threatening response. ESCROW KID broke inward bothering INDIAN DANCE, was righted and sent up to a minimal early advantage, dueled inside the winner into the turn, chased past the five sixteenths marker then tired.
