STAR MAGIC , wide, bid for the lead in upper stretch and narrowly prevailed. PRETTY NIFTY bumped with WITCHY MOON leaving the starting gate, stalked the pace behind a wall of horses, swung very wide entering the stretch, closed and drifted out late. TRUE ROYALTY , steadied in traffic near the half mile pole, was steadied behind horses near the quarter pole then rallied in the three path. CARMEL VALLEY MOON , fanned six wide entering the stretch, reached contention in midstretch then weakened. WITCHY MOON dueled inside and weakened. SPRED SATIN disputed the pace two wide between horses and weakened. LADY HECK fell back early. TOP TIME , six wide on the turn, was outrun.
