Footnotes

TODAY'S MAN rated close up three wide, moved to a clear lead after six furlongs, opened up under pressure nearing mid stretch, held sway then returned sore and was vanned off. HI HO BAMBINO stalked the pace while saving ground, angled out mid way on the final turn, made a run at the winner in upper stretch, continued willingly and was well clear of the rest. TEMPLE RUN was sent up from the outside to go clear early, angled in to set a moderate early pace, took pressure from the five eighths pole, was overtaken past the three furlong marker, chased the winner into the lane, faded and shifted out near mid stretch. HILL CROSSING was sent widest early and gained a stalking position, moved two wide to forced the pace two wide mid way down the backstretch, continued to force the pace to the quarter pole then tired. POLISHED broke a step slow, settled back off the pace, angled out three wide nearing the lane and came up empty. SMILING JORDAN lacked speed, raced wide nearing the far turn and dropped back.
