QUEEN HYPOLITA disputed the pace along the inside, battled back nearing mid stretch to take command and edged away under steady handling. TWO FER PLACE , a bit sluggish from the gate, moved up four wide into the turn, kicked clear nearing mid stretch, was headed nearing the furlong marker, gave way grudgingly and just lasted for the place. TAMAYROSE , between rivals early, angled out near the three eighths pole, circled four to five wide into the lane and closed steadily. CRAFTY DIVA saved ground, was steadied entering the turn, angled out but lacked a solid response. TRAUMATIC , away alertly, dueled two wide through a solid early pace then gave way in upper stretch. NATTIE NU saved ground early and failed to respond. ATLANTIC PRINCESS chased the pace three wide, lodged a mild bid early turn, pressed briefly and tired.
