TOE SHOES sped to the front, set the pace near the rail and increased her advantage through the stretch while under brisk urging. EMPRESS LISA saved ground, chased the pace and held the place. DANCED ALL NIGHT stumbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground and flattened out. FAVORITE BABY saved ground and passed tired foes. DISCOS WISH circled the turn and gave way. KOURAGES KELLY, wide leaving the turn, was not a factor. HARVEST LISA, three wide, chased the pace, drifted out entering the stretch then faltered. SATIN ROSE, steadied in tight quarters near the half mile pole, swung very wide entering the stretch and was not a factor.
