Footnotes

LADY JUNE BUG rated forwardly off of a quick pace, moved three wide to engage HER ROYAL HONOR mid turn, dueled on a short lead into the stretch, drifted in under right handed pressure when going clear inside the eighth pole then steadily widened under a drive. HER ROYAL HONOR quickly went clear, set the pace towards the inside, met the challenge of the winner mid turn, dueled to mid stretch, altered out off heels past the furlong grounds then stayed on well to save the place. SNOW FLURRY saved ground, moved closer mid turn, dropped back under urging entering the stretch then came back gamely in the final seventy yards. ROCK N MARY , three to four wide chasing between rivals, came up empty. UNANIMOUS CONSENT , brushed at the break, was taken to rate between rivals early, made a slight run between foes entering the stretch, shifted in a bit when coaxed to her correct lead then flattened out. BUCCELLA lost ground four to five wide chasing the pace and faded. MALI , brushed and pinched back at the break, was outrun.
