Footnotes

THE CALLER broke slowly, advanced along the rail down the backstretch, stalked the duel, eased out three wide mid way on the turn, secured command in upper stretch then drew out under steady handling. REGAL RETURN saved ground, disputed the pace, was no match for the winner but came home best of the others. QUEEN ZORI lacked speed, saved ground on the turn and passed tired foes. FORTY FOUR LOCO stalked the pace, moved up three wide on the turn, raced on his left lead in the stretch and gave way inside the three sixteenths pole. SPICER CUB , wide leaving the turn, was outrun. THE ADMIRAL'SFLANK , wide turning for home, was outrun. WHEELING FEELING dueled two wide and faltered in upper stretch.
