PROUD PEARL was rated back from between rivals leaving the three quarter pole and tracked the pace three wide, responded when set down in upper stretch, forged to command near the three sixteenths marker, opened up a clear lead a a furlong out, drifted out when confronted with about sixty yards remaining then held firm once corrected. THEATRICALITY , taken to rate back off the early pace, gained in hand between rivals leaving the half mile marker, angled out four wide continuing an advance into the stretch, ranged up outside the winner near the sixteenth marker, switched to her left lead soon after, was floated out a touch then hung. TWO HEARTS IN ONE , unhurried early, commenced a rail run leaving the three eighths pole, angled out four wide for the drive, closed the gap and continued on well after the wire. DAFINA broke inward then was straightened and moved up inside to take command, shook clear after some early pressure, set the pace to the quarter pole, gave some resistance then faded in the final furlong. HONEST TRUTH saved ground off the pace, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. BOUDICCA vied briefly between, eased back past the six furlong pole, stalked the pace in about the two path, shifted in entering the stretch and gave way. WONDERFUL SECRET broke outward, lost ground four to five wide and faded. STELLAR PRINCESS stalked the early pace three to four wide, faltered mid turn and was eased through the final furlong.
