Footnotes

BERNADETTE'S SONG raced between horses, was steadied two wide near the quarter pole, eased out in upper stretch, closed and narrowly prevailed. VESTED IN TOWN set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. PURPLISH broke slowly, advanced along the rail down the backstretch, stalked the pace, eased out four wide entering the stretch and gave way the final furlong. SQUABBLE prompted the pace outside VESTED IN TOWN and faltered. RECESSION PROOF was outrun. LOOSELY hugged the rail and steadily dropped back. DOMINIX circled the turn and faltered. TOUSSAUD'S SPIRIT stopped and was eased.
