BRUSH CREEK prompted the pace two wide between horses, secured command entering the stretch, opened up in midstretch and held sway under energetic urging. COUNT TO SEVEN lacked speed, advanced in the two path entering the lane and rallied inside horses. MYSTICAL TERP, wide on the turn, had a mild rally. QUIET VICTORY worked between horses through the stretch and finished willingly. KLEITTON showed early speed, raced three wide around the turn, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened. WARRENSBURG saved ground, disputed the pace for five furlongs then gave way. ANOTHER BULL RUN trailed and raced along the rail entering the stretch.
