**Footnotes**

BRIMSTONE ISLAND sprinted clear entering the first turn, dropped in some and set a rated pace, responded when asked in upper stretch and pulled away under a vigorous ride. MR. TIME TO GO moved up under rating along the rail near the five eighths pole, tracked the winner to upper stretch, finished willingly but was clearly no match. TONTO prompted the pace two to three wide, was put to a strong drive chasing past the five sixteenths pole, failed to respond and gave way in the lane. THE PACK IS BACK, between rivals early, dropped back near the far turn then passed a couple tired rivals. EDUCATOR lost ground three to four wide leaving the five eighths pole, remained in a forward spot to the far turn then retreated. OUR BAILIWICK was steadied when in close soon after the break, swung out four to five wide entering the lane then gave way.
