WHERE'S DOMINIC rated early, quickly gained two wide entering the stretch, shifted out four wide, closed under right handed pressure and overtook the dueling leaders in deep stretch. SAPHIRE SANDY advanced between runners leaving the three eighths pole and took aim on the leader, knifed through a rail opening to collar the leader into the stretch, dueled, gained a slim advantage a sixteenth out, battled gamely but just wasn't quite good enough. INDEFINABLE HUMOR sprinted clear early, set the pace two wide, widened mid turn, was collared from the inside into the lane, dueled and stayed on well. PEEDS IN A POD broke slowly, was put to hard urging soon after while well out in the track, lost ground six wide mid turn, progressed to a threatening position in mid stretch then flattened out. KEEP MOMMA HAPPY chased the pace four wide and faded. STONELESS gave hard pursuit three wide, began getting out mid turn, drifted outward in upper stretch and faded. STAR MANEUVER saved ground and lacked a bid. DOS ORO, five wide chasing the pace, dropped back.
