TORCHRUNNER circled the turn three wide, floated to the four path entering the stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. GREEN CANYON , outrun to midstretch, split horses near the sixteenth pole and closed with a rush outside the winner. ATHABASKAN HERO sped to the front, saved ground, opened up leaving the turn and gave way late. PELICAN COVE hopped at the break, raced in the three path between horses leaving the turn, was well positioned in midstretch then lacked the needed late response. MIDNIGHT TERROR , in the two path between horses entering the stretch, lacked the necessary rally. BROAD MOON lacked speed, floated to the seven path in upper stretch then passed tired rivals. SAVINGS N LOAN saved ground, lacked room in upper stretch, angled out and was not a late factor. E QUAKE , four wide on the turn, floated to the five path in upper stretch then gave way. BOSS MAN SUE , six wide in upper stretch, was outrun. BLACK FOREST hugged the rail and stopped.
