KAYLBARB , three wide early, dueled towards the inside entering the turn, took pressure around the turn, repelled a challenge from VOEUX entering the stretch, responded to stout left handed urging, went clear in the final furlong and held sway. VOEUX vied between rivals early, was rated back off the dueling leaders leaving the five eighths pole, moved three wide to challenge entering the stretch, forced the issue to mid stretch, continued willingly and saved the place. GLORIOUS NOTION broke a step slow, was taken to rate early, moved closer along the rail leaving the three eighths pole, swung out four wide nearing the lane, made steady progress leaving the eighth pole, hung and was edged for second. BETRAYED , well placed off of a contested pace, failed to respond. LONESOME lacked speed, angled out for the drive but failed to menace. RUNWAY TWIGGY forced the early issue along the inside, chased the leaders past the three eighths pole then tired in upper stretch. GO LUV , four wide early, dueled into the turn, continued to force the pace to the three eighths pole then surrendered.
