ODOM advanced inside leaving the chute and gained a stalking spot while under rating, eased out and came three wide for the drive, wandered outward under left handed pressure when rallying in mid stretch, had his rider go the right stick for correction, drifted in towards BIG MONSTER in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, straightened away soon after, dueled under strong handling and forged ahead in the final strides. BIG MONSTER , eager to the lead, set a rated pace inside, took some pressure after a half mile, moved back clear under some rating into the lane, opened up when roused, was engaged by the winner a sixteenth out, dueled but failed to hold. GOING TO MARKET prompted the pace outside BIG MONSTER, moved to challenge after a half mile, forced the issue under urging into the lane then continued on willingly while managing to save the show. CHARGE bumped with PENDING ASSET at the break, settled back off the pace while saving ground, commenced a rail run leaving the five sixteenths marker, altered outward in upper stretch and finished up with good energy. BRAVACCIO lacked speed while off the rail, was hard ridden between rivals nearing the three eighths pole but failed to respond. PENDING ASSET , bumped at the break, steadied when in close between rivals the opening quarter, recovered to chase the pace three wide into the turn then dropped after five furlongs. HARBOR LYNX lost ground four wide, came under strong urging before going a half mile, lacked a kick and faltered through the final three eighths.
