BOWMAN'S BOY saved ground stalking the pace while patiently rated behind horses, swung outside near the three sixteenths pole, closed steadily and was along in time. ATTENBOROUGH advanced in the three path leaving the backstretch to take the lead, set the pace well off the rail and weakened late. GYPSY BARON saved ground, prompted the pace through the stretch and faded in the drive. IN GOD'S COUNTRY , swung to the five path entering the stretch, rallied mildly. SABA ROCK chased the pace three wide around the turn and weakened through the lane. CATTAIL CREEK , outrun, passed tired horses. SOUTH OF DIXIE , swung wide turning for home, gave way. KAY ONE hugged the rail and faltered. CAN DO KID , six wide leaving the turn, was no factor. EL PICHON trailed.
