ORE PASS relaxed about three wide tracking a contested pace, advanced four wide within himself approaching the lane, forged clear in upper stretch, responded when put to a drive in mid stretch and held firm. ALPHA MIKE FOXTROT bore out the break, was straightened away and settled off the rail, gained ground four wide mid turn, shifted out wider for the drive and closed willingly. LUNAR ROCK, bumped at the break, saved ground off the pace, eased out and advanced between runners near the quarter pole, kept on willingly to mid stretch then flattened out. SAINT ARBOR disputed the pace two wide and weakened nearing mid stretch. KEEP THE CANOLI saved ground, got through making some progress into the lane, bumped with PATRICK S in upper stretch then came up empty. TWELVE STONE, between rivals near the three eighths pole, had no response. PATRICK S broke outward and bumped with LUNAR ROCK, rushed up inside to take a short lead, set a pressured pace around the turn, gave way entering the lane two wide, drifted in bumping KEEP THE CANOLI soon after, lost his action and retreated.
