TOO TOO DIVINE stalked the pace under patient handling, moved up two wide on the far turn, took command approaching the eighth pole and drew out under urging. SHELDONS JET was unruly behind the starting gate, sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and weakened. TOOKIN DOWN lacked speed, raced between horses on the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied mildly. CASE OF THE BLUES raced between horses on the far turn and failed to sustain her bid. UNBRIDLED LADY raced between horses and was steadied lacking room near the three and a half furlongs pole. PROUD OWNER raced wide and failed to rally. CHILLING PROSPECT raced wide, gave way and eased. PRIZED STAMP prompted the pace two wide, stopped and was pulled up. .
