Footnotes

SELF DEALIN' MAN , taken to rate while off the rail, moved closer four wide leaving the five sixteenths marker, rallied under solid left handed pressure to put a head in front in mid stretch then was fully extended to hold sway. DUKE OF DEVON rated forwardly while off the rail, moved three wide between rivals nearing the quarter pole, angled out five wide in the drive and finished gamely to steadily gain. ROMAN BAY gained a clear lead while two wide five furlongs out, angled in entering the turn, took pressure around the turn, dueled in upper stretch, was headed nearing the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly. FIRST NITE prompted the pace three wide into the turn, applied pressure two wide after a half mile, dueled in upper stretch, battled between rivals leaving the eighth pole then faded in the final yards. SHOOKSTOWN ROAD moved up along the rail nearing the five eighths pole and gained a tracking position, steadied when a bit headstrong into the turn, waited along the rail nearing the quarter pole, angled out in upper stretch then closed the gap late while in some traffic. WOODLAND FLUTE , brushed at the break, chased the pace while off the rail and weakened in upper stretch.
