MIDNIGHT MUSIC , two wide between horses on the turn, was fanned wide in upper stretch, closed and drove clear. KLEARLY INSPIRED lacked speed, raced in the seven path in upper stretch and rallied late. DEAR STRANGER saved ground, swung to the four path in upper stretch and rallied between horses. ANYMAGICATALL saved ground on the turn, eased out three wide in upper stretch and flattened out. WHO'S THIS raced along the rail through the stretch and failed to sustain her bid. AUNT CHICK , well off the rail between horses in the stretch, lacked the needed late effort. INCASED IN GOLD set the pace in the two path entering the stretch and gave way. MARIA BLANCA , six wide in upper stretch, was bumped by EYES ROAR in midstretch. TORRANTULA saved ground and was no factor. EYES ROAR , wide entering the stretch, bore out near the eighth pole. DATZFAST was outrun. QUARTERS UP was outrun. .
