SOUTHAFRICAN BALL , fractious behind the starting gate, sped to the front, set the pace near the rail and was kept to her business in the drive. SEA SLIDE , unhurried early, swung wide leaving the turn and rallied. SILENT JET chased the pace, raced three wide entering the stretch and weakened. FLYING WILDCAT , very wide turning for home, passed tired rivals. LUCKY FLYER lacked speed, raced six wide entering the stretch, drifted in in midstretch, raced along the rail the final sixteenth of a mile and was not a factor. WAKE UP MAGGIE circled the turn, chased the pace four wide into the stretch then gave way in the drive. KATHRYN'S SPIRIT , wide entering the stretch, was outrun. DAMIANA was outrun. I'LL BE THE BOSS stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail turning for home and gave way. RUN ALEXA was outrun.
