Footnotes

SOUTHERN RAINBOW disputed the pace outside POPPY'S PUNKIN, opened a clear lead in midstretch and lasted under energetic urging. INDEPENDENT BANKER lacked speed, saved ground, angled out near the eighth pole and rallied between horses. RICHARD'S KID lacked speed, swung to the six path near the quarter pole and rallied. CAVE'S VALLEY raced off the duel, was well off the rail in the stretch and gave way. EASY RED circled the turn and failed to rally. HIGH BLUES, five wide near the quarter pole, was not a factor. BALANCED ATTACK gave way. POPPY'S PUNKIN dueled along the rail and faltered.
