**Footnotes**

RISKY RED , four wide the first turn, settled back off the dueling leaders, commenced a four wide run nearing the far turn, moved four wide to a short lead after six furlongs, dueled into the stretch, responded to left handed urging in mid stretch then pulled away while kept to a drive. GUSTAUFG saved ground, advanced into the far turn, lodged a rail bid leaving the three eighths pole, dueled inside the winner entering the lane, held well to mid stretch, faded but remained clear for the place. LONDON TOWN , taken to rate between rivals early, moved up behind rivals leaving the far turn, shifted out some for the drive but lacked a solid response. TEA TOTT dueled early along the rail, was rated back a bit and angled out leaving the four and a half furlong marker, came back three wide between rivals leaving the three eighths pole, battled to the head of the stretch then gave way. KING'S RANSOM , three wide early, failed to respond. DESTINEDTOBEMINE broke a step slow, was hustled up between rivals entering the first turn and engaged TEA TOTT, dueled outside that rival to the five eighths pole, kicked clear after a half mile, was joined leaving the far turn, continued a presence to the five sixteenths pole and tired.
