Footnotes

HOT FUN , fractious in the gate, drafted towards the rail and was allowed to settle early, steadied off the heels of HORSIN' AROUND near the far turn as that one was maneuvered inward, recovered while continuing to save ground, made her way out to about the six path when picking up steam into the stretch, closed determinedly under left handed pressure and got up at the wire. HAILEY'S STAR bobbled at the break then bumped with HORSIN' AROUND, regrouped to save ground and moved forwardly into the turn, angled out mid turn, ranged up four wide outside rivals into the stretch, drifted outward when set down left handed leaving the three sixteenths pole, was straightened away past the furlong pole, rallied to command inside the sixteenth marker, finished gamely but was nipped at the finish. EK HASEENA , eager to go on between rivals, popped her head in front near the three eighths pole, took pressure from both sides into the stretch, kept on with a tenuous lead to the sixteenth marker, drifted in and failed to hold. HORSIN' AROUND , bumped at the break, was angled in nearing the turn, crept closer in the two path into the stretch, swung out from behind rivals leaving the eighth pole and finished with interest. MISSY RULES veered out at the break, straightened soon after and moved up three wide, pressed the pace to mid stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. LADY ALLEY GATOR , away well, set a pressured early pace inside, was overtaken leaving the far turn, battled willingly to the eighth pole then surrendered.
