Footnotes

THE VIN MAN , in mid pack early, was put the whip while three wide around the turn, eased out wider for the drive, closed steadily under pressure, took command near the sixteenth marker and edged clear. DIAMOND FLYER chased the pace, lodged a rail bid in upper stretch, dueled past the eighth pole and held well. DISCO DANDY was sent clear soon after the break, set the pace off the rail, took pressure around the turn, dueled nearing mid stretch then weakened late. FOXS UPTOWN BOY , outrun early, saved ground entering the lane, angled out nearing mid stretch and finished willingly. TROPICAL SOLDIER pressed the pace three wide and weakened near mid stretch. JIGALONG lacked speed, raced wide in the drive and had some belated action. PUSH N. BOOTS , wide, failed to keep pace. LIL MOON MAN , reluctant to load, was outrun.
