WORLD GONE WRONG prompted the pace three wide, moved to challenge a quarter out, took command four wide in upper stretch, responded to right handed urging inside the furlong marker then was fully extended to hold sway. LOOKIN' FOXY lagged well back for a half mile, raced seven wide in the drive, closed gamely on her left lead and was getting to the winner. LITTLE MISS KISSES broke a bit awkwardly then steadied soon after, was taken five wide soon after and rushed up to command after a quarter mile, gained a clear advantage after three furlongs, was collared approaching the lane, battled inside the winner past the furlong marker and stayed on well. FAITHFUL ONE bobbled a bit leaving the gate, was taken to rate off the rail, came four wide into the lane and finished with interest. SWALLOW FALLS stalked the early pace, dropped back nearing the turn, shifted out and circled five wide into the stretch then lacked a rally. SMART ODDS , off the rail failed to menace. ALL FOR BROOK chased the pace off the rail and gave way in upper stretch. TOSSABOUQUET saved ground chasing the pace and weakened .
