ANGEL PUNCH raced seven wide in upper stretch and passed tired ones. SPECTACULAR PLACE set the pace along the rail and faded. TIME IS MONEY raced wide and failed to rally. PLEASANT NOTE broke in the air, raced along the rail and passed tired ones. TALKIN MONEY pressed the pace two wide and gave way. NICLIE , very wide, gave way. DAWN EDITION dropped back. LONG CHUN was outrun.
