Footnotes

VICTORY STORMER gained command along the inside nearing the half mile marker, set a pressured pace, edged clear nearing the lane then dug in under a drive. SHAMSS stalked the pace three wide, loomed nearing mid stretch, continued well under strong handling but could not gain. CONNECTICAT , in tight at the break, raced far back for a half mile, saved ground into the lane, angled out, split rivals leaving the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. FURRIARIAT lost ground four wide stalking the pace and gave way nearing mid stretch. MEADOW JUMPER , bumped at the break, raced four wide in upper stretch and failed to respond. A BRIDLED TIGER broke on top, was urged along two wide contesting the pace, battled to upper stretch then gave way.
