**Footnotes**

LIPSTICK TRACES showed speed two wide entering the turn, lost the lead leaving the bend, hugged the rail through the stretch and closed determinedly to get up in time. DANCE OFF moved up in the three path entering the turn, gained the lead approaching the stretch, opened a clear lead in midstretch then weakened late. CAFE RENDEZVOUS circled the turn three wide and had a slight rally outside foes. BAYOU BOOGALOO , pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced in the two path on the turn and failed to be a factor. LIGHT THE HUGHES bore in leaving the starting gate, showed speed along the rail, weakened and swung outside in upper stretch. OTTAUQUECHEE outrun along the rail, swung wide in midstretch.
