Footnotes

BRI'S VISION , patiently rated, moved up three wide leaving the turn, angled to the inner rail in upper stretch, closed nicely and drew clear under brisk urging. ONE TO A ROYAL had speed along the rail, was a bit rank early, rated back inside the five eighths pole, angled out entering the turn, entered the stretch four wide then hung. HITCHIN' TOTHEMOON moved up in the three path leaving the backstretch, gained the lead in upper stretch and weakened the final furlong. HAIL TO THE CHIEF saved ground around the turn, eased out in upper stretch and failed to menace. B FOR BEEZ , three wide between horses leaving the turn, angled outside in midstretch, failed to menace and passed faders. ALL FOR PEACE set a pressured pace in the two path and weakened in midstretch. MO'S BRO , between horses, weakened. VALUED TRUST , wide turning for home, was outrun. BETH'S MARK saved ground but was outrun. WOHALI , wide on the turn, drifted out entering the stretch then dropped back.
