TALK IS MONEY raced four wide to the far turn while prompting the pace, dueled with MARCIANO from the three furlong marker, gained a short lead leaving the eighth pole and proved best under a steady drive. MARCIANO set a pressured pace in the two path, dueled inside the winner from the three furlong marker and finished gamely. BAY EAGLE was taken to rate while off the rail, angled in around the final turn, saved ground into the stretch and rallied. WELCOME MATT broke a step slow, saved ground early, angled out, made a wide run into the far turn, angled in some around the final turn, entered the lane four wide and flattened out. NINER'S ECHO saved ground in close pursuit, dropped back some into the far turn, angled out in the lane and lacked a solid response. JAKEY D raced three wide around the final turn and failed to menace. DANZIG'S PEACE was rated back off of the early leaders around the first turn, faltered after a half mile and was eased late. ACTION REQUEST pressed the pace three wide, faltered before going six furlongs and was being eased.
