HANDSOME BRUNO set the early pace two wide, kicked away from EDGEWATER leaving the three quarter pole and angled in some, took pressure into the stretch, was overtaken leaving the quarter pole, dueled through the final furlong and just got the bob under stout left handed pressure. EDGEWATER bobbled at the break, was sent up inside the winner near the six furlong marker, rated back off that one approaching the five eighths pole and angled out, came back between rivals to challenge in upper stretch, dueled on a slim lead leaving the sixteenth marker, finished gamely but was edged. VICTORY LAKE settled back along the inside, advanced along the rail nearing the stretch, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and closed willingly. TORPEDO RUN, unhurried early while off the rail, ranged up four to five wide into the stretch, gained a brief lead nearing mid stretch then faded. KAUFY BIG SHOT saved ground in a stalking position, moved up behind rivals into the stretch, angled out some and came up empty. C STREET, three to four wide, was put to a ride leaving the half mile marker and failed to respond. QUIET SEARCH settled in mid pack while off the rail, lodged a three to four wide bid between rivals into the stretch then weakened in the final three sixteenths.
