**Footnotes**

LUCKY HOLLY prompted the early pace three wide under snug rating, moved two wide to join TRIPLE PICK after a half mile, dueled under continued rating into the lane, shook clear a sixteenth out, came out in deep stretch under left handed pressure impeding GANZA then narrowly prevailed. RING RING settled off the rail while well in range, came under some urging mid turn, angled out four to five wide for the drive, closed steadily and just missed. GANZA rated forwardly while saving ground, eased out for the drive, rallied leaving the eighth pole then was shut off by the winner in the final yards. GLACKETY settled back inside early, angled out when attempting to rally in upper stretch, altered in late and had some belated action. TRIPLE PICK took command at once, set a slow pace inside, was taken on after a half mile, dueled inside LUCKY HOLLY to mid stretch, weakened the final sixteenth while on her left lead then nearly lost her rider when jumping a shadow just prior to the wire. HARPER LEE stalked the early pace two wide then faltered between rivals leaving the three eighths pole. Following a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of GANZA, LUCKY HOLLY was disqualified from first and placed third for causing interference in deep stretch
