### Footnotes

E. Z. PATH set the pace near the rail, drifted out slightly entering the stretch, drifted out badly near the sixteenth pole and lasted. SLICK VIC , in the three path entering the stretch, rallied between horses. GARDEN TOUR stalked the pace, was in the four path near the quarter pole, advanced to midstretch then failed to sustain his bid. ASYLUM , swung to the four path entering the stretch, passed tired foes. GIANT PATRIOT saved ground, eased out near the three eighths pole and weakened in the drive. TOMORROWS WILDCAT , wide on the turn, entered the stretch in the five path and weakened. LIONOFWALLSTREET , near the rail, chased the pace and gave way. SILVER SLUGGER saved ground and gave way. CAPTAIN CRENCHE was not a factor. KLEITON trailed.
