HOLME SWIFTLY set the pace inside while under rating, was set down in upper stretch and edged away. DANCE WITH ANNIE angled to the rail soon after the start, advanced inside near the quarter pole, swung out wide in upper stretch and closed willingly to gain the place late. TALENTED TOES raced inside, moved closer into the lane then flattened out. SECRET'S LAST SAY, two wide early, angled out in mid stretch and offered a mild late response. BELLES CHAMP pressed the winner in the two path, was put to the whip near the quarter pole and tired. TRYSTER was no factor. VIRGINIA PUNCH raced three to four wide and had no response. BRIGHT AURA, three wide early, dropped back. LADY HIAWATHA pulled up lame.
