HOT SALSA rated close up towards the inside, advanced the final turn, eased out three wide for the drive and wore down ABOARD in a hard drive. ABOARD set the pace along the inside, was headed briefly the final turn, went briefly clear in mid stretch and stayed gamely. MO HOTTA MO BETTA, under stout restraint three wide, lodged a bid nearing the far turn, put a head in front mid way on the final turn, dueled in upper stretch then faded. STOP THAT BROAD, void of speed, circled the final turn, was floated very wide in upper stretch and lacked a rally. FINAL ONE, wide the first turn, drifted out entering the lane and weakened. LEAVE NO PRINTS pressed the pace in the two path until the far turn and tired. HOLIDAY BALL, four wide the first turn and backstretch, dropped back after six furlongs. GLADYS J lost ground racing five wide until the second turn and faltered.
