RAGTIME DOLL, patiently rated to the turn, swung wide approaching the stretch, closed nicely under steady handling and drew out. BARN WIFE circled the turn, challenged for the lead in upper stretch and hung. CRAB IMPERIAL slipped through along the rail to reach contention in mid stretch and flattened out. CHEAP DIGS, in hand between horses on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, was put to the whip near the sixteenth pole and closed belatedly. BRISK BREEZE raced wide into the stretch and was no factor. TOOKIN DOWN, outrun, raced very wide into the lane. LYRICAL GHOST prompted the pace racing in the two path and fell back. WHATA VALAY GIRL had speed along the rail and stopped.
