BONGEE dueled two wide, took command on the turn, quickly widened nearing the furlong marker and proved much the best under a drive. JACQUELYN T settled towards the inside, angled out mid turn, advanced between rivals entering the lane and closed willingly. HELLO LONELINESS prompted the pace three wide and came up empty. APACHE BEE broke inward, saved ground while advancing near the half mile marker, had her rider's saddle slip near the three eighths pole, angled out and finished willingly under her own courage. NO DISPUTE, removed from the rail, failed to respond. SKIT dueled inside of the winner to the quarter pole then gave way. WINTER CLOUDS failed to menace. A BARRY GOOD GIRL lost ground four to five wide and failed to threaten.
