BENRAY'S FLASH , showing improved speed, raced three wide around the turn, dueled through the stretch and narrowly prevailed. RICO ENDS WELL , two wide on the backstretch, dueled inside the winner and finished gamely. WEST IS WEST , unhurried early, raced three wide turning for home and flattened out. CARNIE'S SECRET saved ground and lacked the needed late effort. QUPPY , wide around the turn, weakened. MAGGIE'S LAST CALL , blocked leaving the turn, swung very wide in upper stretch and failed to menace. SHOWMETHEGREENCARD , no factor, raced very wide. TASTE THE JOY , unhurried early, raced wide and was no factor. STORM'S SECRET had speed along the rail and gave way. MIMSY bobbled leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail and was outrun. .
